WHEREAS, Redevelopment; and, This prestigious accolade is being bestowed upon the Cracker Factory in the category of Historic District

WHEREAS, REAS, A collaboration of H.H.G. Development and the New Jersey Housing and Mortgage Finance Agency, the Cracker Factory project converted a vacant and deteriorated storage warehouse into a premier green workforce housing development, adding value to the local neighborhood while preserving the architectural integrity of the structure; and,

WHEREAS, REAS, The Cracker Factory, which features eighteen one- and two-bedroom lofts with gardens, terraces, and garages, stands as a sterling example of how redevelopment that respects historic assets can garner community support and enhance neighborhood vitality; and,

XEAS, In addition, the Cracker Factory, which was completed in 2009, incorporates such exemplary green technologies as solar panels, energy-efficient electric heat pumps, thermal windows, and Energy Star-compliant appliances; and,
